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

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Abstract. Uncertainty is an unavoidable component of our life and fuzzy set theory (FST) is generally explored to deal with it. However, in some complex situations FST is not capable to play crucial role. In such situations Picture fuzzy set (PFS) come into the picture which is the direct extension of FST and Intuitionistic fuzzy set (IFS). Although different studies on FST and IFS have been done including their algebraic structure, however these studies are found to be inappropriate to deal with picture fuzzy situations. In this regard, this present paper presents the basic arithmetic operations on PFSs along with numerical examples. Finally application of PFSs in multi-criteria group decision making is performed through a case study.



1 Introduction


Fuzzy set theory (FST) was developed by Zadeh [1] in the year 1965 to deal with uncertain environment in solving various problems of real world. FST provides an appropriate framework for representing vague concepts by allowing partial membership. After that the intuitionistic fuzzy set (IFS) was proposed by Atanassov [2] in 1986. An IFS has the characteristics of fulfilling two functions expressing the degree of membership (belongingness) and the degree of non membership (non belongingness) of the elements of the universe to the IFS and the sum of these two degrees must not exceed one. It is encountered that one of the novel idea viz., degree of neutrality, is lacking in IFS. 1. INTRODUCTION:



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
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Numerical Investigation on Stagnation Point Flow Along a Vertical Stretching Sheet with Soret and Dufour Effects

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Abstract

The current analysis is devoted to observing the influence of Soret and Dufour effects on MHD stagnation point flow along a vertical stretching sheet. Effects of variable viscosity and thermal conductivity are also considered in our study. The governing equations of flow are transformed into ordinary differential equations using similarity transformations and which are solved numerically by using Runge-Kutta fourth order scheme with shooting technique. The significant properties and effects of various physical parameters such as viscosity variation parameter, thermal conductivity variation parameter, Soret number, Dufour number, Hartmann number on velocity, temperature and species concentration distributions are presented through graphs.

Keywords: Soret and Dufour effects, variable viscosity, variable thermal conductivity, shooting technique.

1. Introduction

In the process in fluid flow induced by coupled heat and mass transfer, Soret and Dufour effects must not be neglected. Stagnation point flow is also relevant to the bodies in high speed flow. It is used to reduce drag, in designing of thrust bearings and transpiration cooling etc. Stagnation point flow was first analyzed by Hiemenz^[1]. Hiemenz used similarity transformation to reduce the governing Navier-Stokes equation into ordinary differential equations of third order subject

to two point boundary conditions. Later many researches considered magnetic field, heat source/sink, suction/injection etc. to enhance the properties of fluids in stagnation point flow.

The boundary layer fluid flow with the occurrence of coupled heat and mass transfer have significant contributions in heat insulation, compact heat exchangers, paper production, drying technology and catalytic reactor^[2]. The mass transfer created by the temperature gradient is called the Soret effect (thermo-diffusion).

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ABSTRACT: Symmetry is one of the most pervasive concepts in the universe. It is used in our everyday language in two meanings. In the one sense symmetry means something like well-proportioned, well-balanced and the other sense. Symmetry denotes the sort of concordance of several parts by which they integrate into a whole. The study of symmetry provides one of the most appealing applications of group theory. The systematic mathematical treatment of symmetry is called group theory. Group theory is a rich and powerful subject by which we shall confine our use of it at this stage classification of molecules in terms of their symmetry properties, the construction of molecular orbitals and the analysis of molecular vibrations. To make the idea of molecular symmetry as useful as possible we must develop some rigid mathematical criteria of symmetry. Group theory is the tool by means of which generalizations concerning molecular symmetry are applied. In the advanced study of inorganic chemistry a systematic study of symmetry and the ways of specifying it with mathematical precision are important because wide variety of symmetric structure encountered.

INTRODUCTION

Symmetry governs the physical and spectroscopic properties of molecules. Sets of symmetry operations constitute a mathematical group. Group theory is the mathematical application of symmetry to an object to obtain knowledge of its physical properties. By using the properties of groups, we can take advantage of molecular symmetry in a systematic way to predict the properties of molecules and to simplify molecular calculations. Molecular symmetry is a fundamental concept in Chemistry. The simple intuitive grasp of symmetry that most observant people naturally acquire is adequate for understanding chemistry up to a point. Many molecules have a certain degree of symmetry; methane is a tetrahedral molecule; benzene is hexagonal and so on. But in order to make the idea of molecular symmetry as useful as possible we must develop some rigid mathematical criteria of symmetry. We shall consider the kinds of symmetry elements that a molecule may have and the symmetry operations generated by the symmetry elements. We shall use the general properties of groups to aid in correctly and systematically determining the symmetry operation of any molecule [1].

SYMMETRY ELEMENTS AND OPERATIONS

A symmetry element is a geometrical entity such as a line, a plane or a point with respect to which one or more symmetry operations may be carried out. On the other hand a symmetry operation is a movement of a body such that, after the movement has been carried out, every point of the body is coincident with an equivalent point of the body in its original orientation [3].

There are two systems of symbols for representing symmetry elements:

- (i) The Schonflies system, which is used primarily for molecular geometry and group theory.
- (ii) The Hermann-Mauguin system, which is used in crystallography.

In this paper the researcher will adopt the conventional use of the Schonflies symmetry notation. For single molecules there are five symmetry elements and corresponding symmetry operations.

The identity operation consists of doing nothing to the molecule. All molecules and other finite bodies – possess identity symmetry. The E-operation although apparently trivial is involved in group theoretical calculations.

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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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
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Concepts and Techniques of Robin S. Ngangom: A Poet of the Soil from North East India

But, some attempts have been made over the last one decade or so to include and discuss the works of Robin S. Ngangom, Desmond Kharmawphlang, Mamang Dai, Yumlembam Ibomcha, Thangjam Ibopishak, Kynpham S. Nangkymnyh in anthologies and academic forum. Identity crisis is the hallmark of Northeast's contemporary politics. This identity has been conceived in essences of ecology and culture of the land. The mega-culture of the region which is a blend of tribal and non-tribal cultures is thwarted by the conflicts of alienation. In many cases the local myths have influenced the identity of the people. All the aspects of identity and problems arising out the identity crisis and social alienation have been the burning social issues of the contemporary era. These issues have been reflected in the poetry written in English by the poets of this region. The poets of North-east India have exploited the history, culture, legends, folklores, mythic dimension. 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Socio-Literary Aspects of Assamese Devotional Song 'Zikir'


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Abstract:


Zikir, in Assamese, were composed by a Sufi Saint named Shah Miran, popularly known as Azan Fakir. In the 16th and 17th century, the Sufi Saints from Central Asia scattered all over the world for the cause of propagating and revitalizing Islam. Among them Shah Miran from Baghdad arrived at Assam during the first half of the 17th century and entered the Ahom kingdom of Swargadeo Pratap Singha. Muslim had already made their way to Assam from North India in different phases since early 13th century and permanently settled in the state. During the hundred years, they had developed a mixed cultural assimilation with the other ethnic and religious groups. Except their names, they had no religious identity. To turn them to their own religious path, Shah Miran composed a new kind of Islamic Devotional song in Assamese language called Zikir. It dealt with the basics of Islam. The musical elements were completely taken from various Assamese folk songs. Propagation and revitalization of Islam is not the only important aspect of Zikir, but the literary quality and cultural significance of the kind of devotional song is the main consideration. The paper examines the literary aspects such as meaning, references, themes, use of language, style of writing etc. in Zikir. It also presents a review of the cultural significance of Zikir such as reflection of social life, religious harmony and other aspects that enrich the Assamese cultural life.

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

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

ASHA and Social Stigma during Covid-19: A Study of Kakojan PHC

Introduction:

The Covid -19 is not only creating health crisis, but also it creates the social crisis in the world which attacks many communities by different ways (UN 2020). Likewise, India is also in a leading position in increasing of affected number of Covid-19. Along with the affected number, the fear and anxiety are being increased among the population. Along with so many problems, covid-19 is creating social stress like social anxiety, attitude of discrimination among the people. The problem of negative discrimination or stigma is faced due to migration, religious hatred during the Covid-19 situation (Singh 2020). Such type of discrimination or problem of stigma is faced by the Covid-19 affected people as well as the health professionals too. Due to the fear and anxiety, people are creating social isolation or stigma to some category of people (UN India 2020).

Stigma is the attribute which creates some negative stereotypes. Sociologists have studied it in macro and micro level perspectives. According to Goffman, stigma is general aspect of life that complicates every micro level interaction. It is the notion of negative attitude towards someone due to their disabilities or illness and some characteristics inherited by them. In the discussion of Link and Phelan, it is found that stigma arises when people label the differences of individual or group and creates some negative attitudes towards the differences. Again, people make them different from normal people and discriminate anyway. Goffman mentions, most people face experience of stigmatized in any phases of life which is noticed in the interactional context (Clair 2018).

There is a relationship between the infectious diseases and stigma for long periods in India. The disease goes on, but not the discriminatory attitude. Incidences of stigma and discrimination have been even faced by the health professionals in India (Mehta 2020). Along with the health workers including doctors to the frontline workers, the migrants; victims of religious trauma have experienced stigma or discrimination in the pandemic situation in India. As stigma arises due to lack of knowledge, illiteracy, etc., therefore stigma related to Covid -19 is the result of people's

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
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
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
