  the flood-related problems and the poor transportation system of that area and would submit a
  demand to take necessary actions to overcome these hurdles so that the people living in the villages
  of the Jhanjimukh could lead a better life.
- A proposal containing the demand for establishing a veterinary health center at Jhanjimukh will be submitted to the office of the Veterinary Department.
