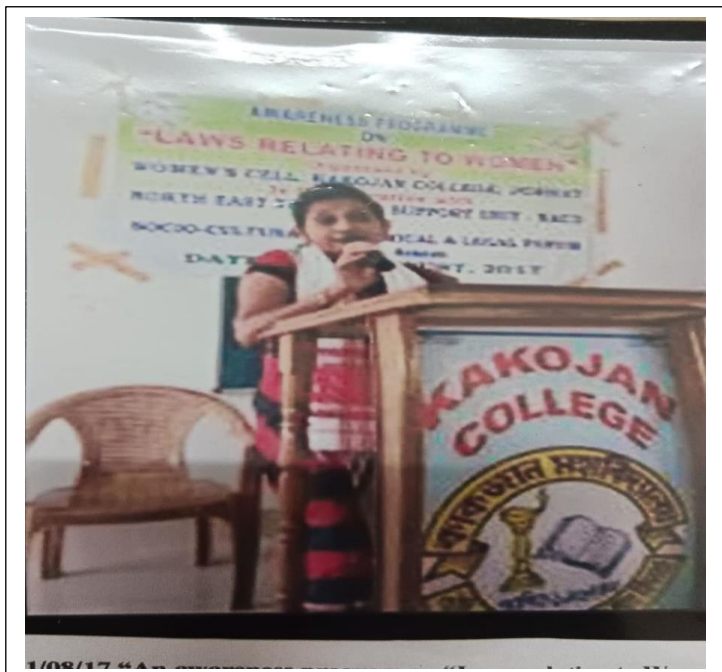
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A Legal Awareness programme on “Laws Relating to Women” on 31/08/2017

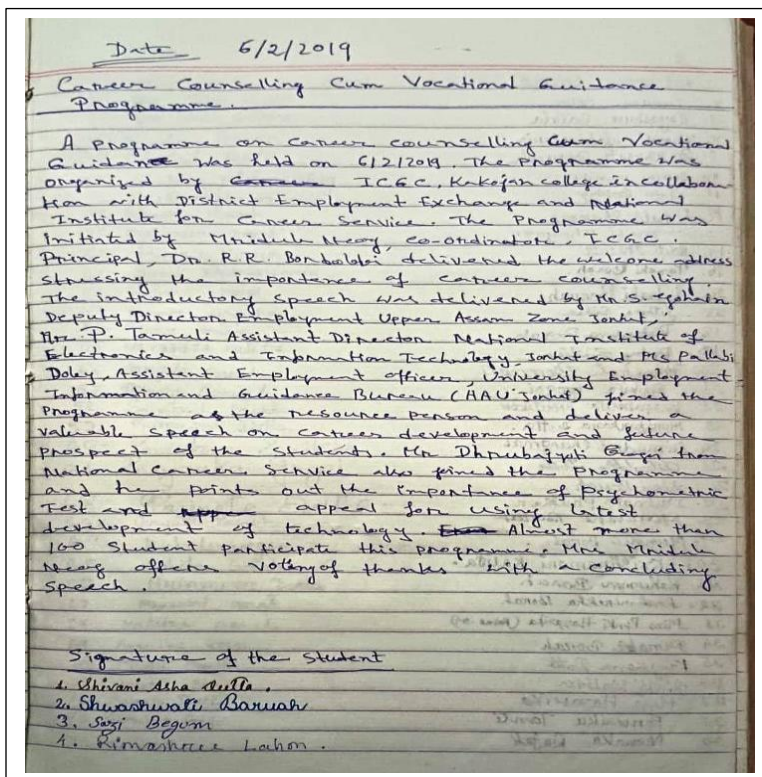

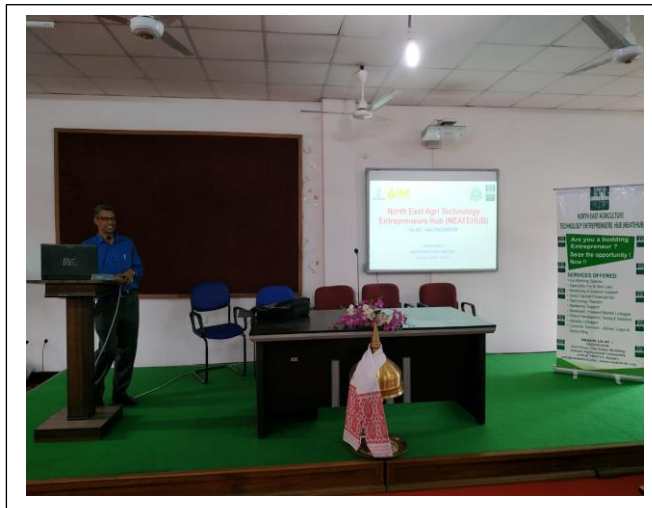

A Field Trip by Centre for Women Studies at Jhanjimukh Area

The **Centre for Women Studies (Women's Cell) of Kakojan College conducted a field trip to Jhanjimukh on 28.10.2020**, with the aims and objectives to gather knowledge regarding the socio-economic status of the inhabitants of the area, to find out the challenges faced by the women and children of the area and to identify the recurring problems which need immediate solutions. A team, comprising of **eight faculty members** of the College, was formed for carrying out the study. The team divided themselves into three groups and visited four villages of the Jhanjimukh Village Panchayat – Kumar Gaon, Kaivartagarh Gaon, Kaman Gaon (new) and Kaman Gaon (old), so as to conduct the survey by random sampling method. **The total household visited by the team was 100.** Based on the data collected from four villages an analysis was made and based on the analysis conclusions were drawn and decided to carry out the following actions:

- To put forward a proposal to the Block Development Officer (Kaliapani Block, Teok) describing the flood-related problems and the poor transportation system of that area and would submit a demand to take necessary actions to overcome these hurdles so that the people living in the villages of the Jhanjimukh could lead a better life.
- A proposal containing the demand for establishing a veterinary health center at Jhanjimukh will be submitted to the office of the Veterinary Department.
