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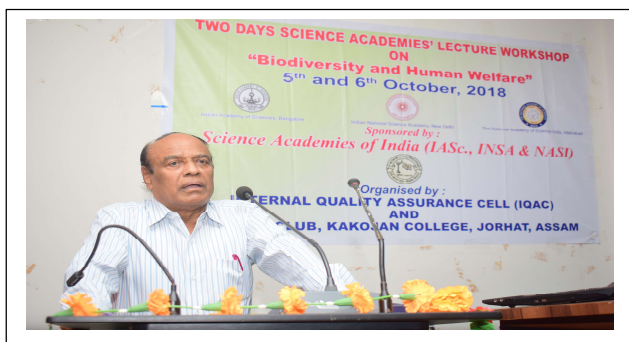

1. TWO DAYS SCIENCE ACADEMICS' LECTURE WORKSHOP

The two days Science Academies lecture workshop on “*Biodiversity and Human Welfare*” was held on Kakojan College premises on 5th and 6th October 2018. The workshop was begun with an introductory speech by Dr. Archana Bhattacharjee, Academic Vice Principal and Co-coordinator of IQAC, Kakojan College. Dr. Hemakanta Hazarika, the President of the Governing body of the college lighted the inaugural lamp and delivered an inaugural speech. From a philosophical perspective, he asserted his view regarding the protection of biodiversity and the human values associated with the subject. It was followed by a welcome address delivered by Dr. Ruprekha Bordoloi, Principal of the college. She extended his welcome to the honorable resource persons and delegates coming from various institutions.

There were eight technical session during the workshop which were chaired by eminent scientist and academician Dr R.R. Rao (INSA honorary scientist, formerly Associate Professor NEHU, Joint Director, BSI and Director grade Scientist, NBRI CIMAP), Dr. K.R. Sivanna and Dr. M Sanjappa; INSA Honorary Scientist and Dr. S. K. Borthakur, Professor, Department of Botany, Gauhati university. Dr. R.R. Rao, Convener of the workshop, in his deliberation focused on the objectives of the Science Academies and informed to the participants that this initiation is boost the image of Science and would provide a platform to the young teachers and students for exploration of their study as well as research. Total 100 participants from eight different institution including the host institution of undergraduate as well as post graduate level and Scientist from RFRI and C.M.E.R. & T.I. have participated in the workshop. All the sessions were highly interactive. All the speakers in their lecture revealed that biodiversity has immense importance in our life; we have to properly use our traditional and scientific knowledge for sustainable utilization of it. 2. ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON SWAYAM

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Kakojan College in collaboration with Education and Multimedia Research Centre, Dibrugarh University organised a one day workshop on **SWAYAM (Study Web of Active Learning for Young Aspiring Minds)** on 25th August, 2018 at the college premise. The workshop was attended by more than seventy enthusiastic participants from the host college as well as different educational institutions of Jorhat district. The three resource persons viz Dr. Jyotirekha G. Handique, Professor, Department of Chemistry, Mrs. Moromi Gogoi, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Dr. Srutidhara Mahanta, Assistant Professor, Director of Distance Education, Dibrugarh University kept the participants enraptured with their thought provoking and enlightening presentation on various aspects of SWAYAM. The interaction that followed after presentation reflected the interest of the participant and their keenness to know more about the application of SWAYAM in the teaching learning process of the CBCS.



3. ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON REVISED ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION FRAMEWORK (RAF)

Kakojan College, Jorhat, Assam hosted a NAAC Sponsored workshop on the **Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework (RAF)** on 18th January, 2019. The purpose behind the workshop was to help create awareness about the new accreditation process and modification introduced in the system since 2017. This paradigm shift in the entire methodology is a unknown domain for most of the institutions, specially located in the rural areas who have not yet completed the 2nd Cycle of accreditation or the new colleges who are yet to start the accreditation process. The workshop was attended by Co-ordinators of IQAC and faculty members of different institutions. The resource person invited to conduct the workshop was Prof. Niranjnan Roy, Professor and Head, Department of Economics, Dean, MG School of Economics and Commerce, Assam University, Silchar. He conducted two technical sessions where he discussed at length issues related with the new accreditation framework viz. (a) From qualitative peer judgement to data based quantitative indicator evaluation increasing objectivity and transparency, (b) Extensive use of ICT confirming scalability, (c) System Generated Scores through third party validations of data, (d) Revised metrics to bring enhanced participation of students and alumni in assessment process. The workshop ended with an interactive session where resource person addressed all the queries and doubts of the participants in a very explicit manner.



4. ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON TORCH BEARER OF CHANGE: BECOMING AN EFFECTIVE TEACHER

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Kakojan College in collaboration with *Council for Teachers' Education* organised a one day workshop on 'Torch Bearer Of Change: Becoming An Effective Teacher' on 19th March, 2019.
