## Day 1

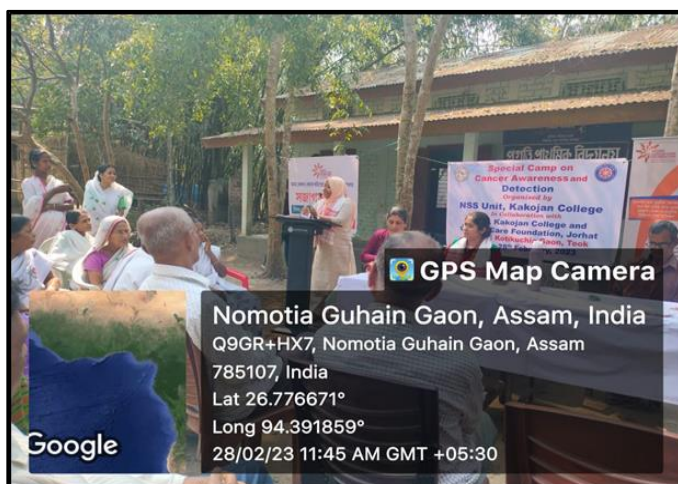
