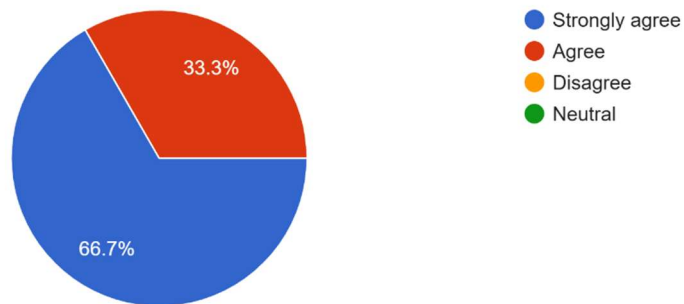
4. The training programmes organized by the institution are helpful
