Report on the IQAC Meeting

On 19th March 2026, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Kakojan College, Jorhat, Assam, organised a meeting with the Principal and faculty members of the institution. The meeting was chaired by Dr. Rashmi Rekha Saikia, Principal of the college. Lakhya Protim Nirmolia, Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), briefly outlined the aims and objectives of the meeting.

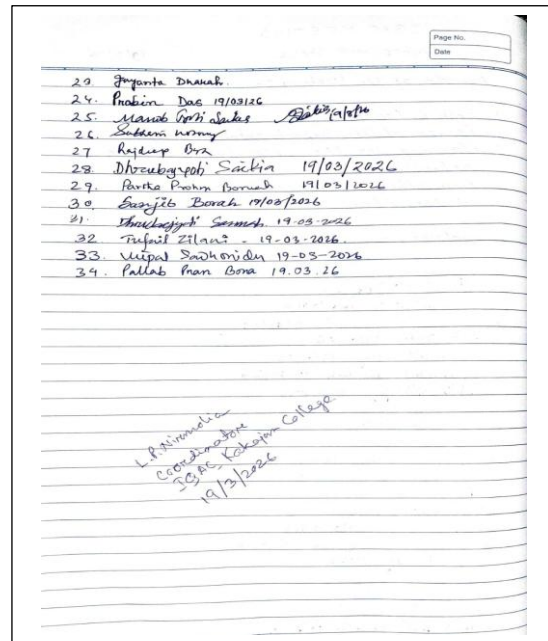
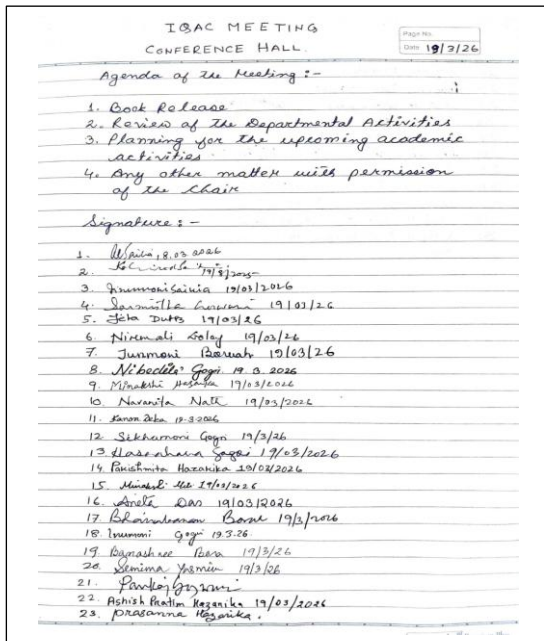
As per the agenda, the Chairperson-cum-Principal released the e-book edited by Lakhya Protim Nirmolia, Tufail Zilani Imdad Ullah, and Utpal Sadhonider, entitled *Ancient Roots, Modern Minds: Rediscovering the Indian Knowledge System*. After releasing the e-book, the Chairperson-cum-Principal opined that the publication of books is a continuous process of academic achievement for the faculty of higher educational institutions. She appreciated the initiative of editing an e-book by the faculty members of the institution, stating that it was a good step that would not only enhance the academic environment but also illuminate the research capabilities of the faculty members.


Addressing the faculty members assembled in the meeting, the Chairperson-cum-Principal, Dr. Rashmi Rekha Saikia, stated that even though the portal of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is closed, the institution should not give up the tasks of the IQAC. She emphasised that it was high time for everyone to work together for the greater interest of the institution. The Principal and the IQAC Coordinator briefly discussed the departmental activities submitted by the respective departments to

the IQAC Coordinator for the current and upcoming academic sessions. The Chairperson-cum-Principal advised all departments to organise Alumni Lecture Series (ALS).

The meeting also discussed upcoming activities, days to be observed, and the role of the NSS and NCC units of the institution. Heads and faculty members of various departments stated that their departments would organise different activities during the upcoming academic session.

With the permission of the Chairperson-cum-Principal, the IQAC Coordinator, in his speech, highlighted the need to improve the land in the B-Sector of Kakojan College. He informed the gathering that since the acquisition of the land in 2013, the area has been developed into an Organic Model Garden. Till date, the garden has produced a substantial amount of organic produce and generated revenue, which has been deposited in the bank account of the institution. In 2025, a classroom block was constructed in the area with financial assistance from the Government of Assam, where classes for the Certificate Course in Organic Farming are currently held. The IQAC Coordinator further submitted a proposal to the Chairperson-cum-Principal for the cultivation of mustard seeds or other suitable crops in the Sector-B area.
