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BRIEF REPORT OF THE FACILITIES PROVIDED & PROVIDE CURRICULAR REPORTS

Report on the initiatives and facilities provided by the Institution:

Kakojan College, the only HEI in Teok Assembly Constituency, was established by the local educationist, rural people to cater the long-standing need of higher education in the particular area. The institution is committed to offer best education to masses especially hailing from agro-based families. The Institution has the following facilities and initiatives for Green campus-

- (a) The Institute has installed 17 solar lights having a capacity of 510 KWH in the existing campus (Sector-A), 1 in the extended campus (Sector-B) and 2 in the Girls' Hostel (Sector-C). Solar lights are used to lighten the college campus.
- (b) To reduce the energy conservation, the Institute has implemented one Rainwater harvesting plant which store rainwater for future use. This attempt not only reduced the energy consumption during pumping of ground water, but also provides water for use.
- (c) The Institution has initiated LED Bulb production Unit under the aegis of Department of Physics in association with IQAC. As LED bulb is safe for environment and can easily be recycled, have no mercury and don't produce blue waves. So, Institution tries to inculcate awareness and entrepreneurial mindset among students.
- (d) The Institute has installed dustbins for waste collection. Green dustbins are used to collect biodegradable organic wastes and Red dustbins are used for Non-biodegradable wastes. The non-biodegradable wastes are sent for recycling or dumping ground while the biodegradable are used for bio-compost generation which are used as organic fertilizer in the garden of the institution.
- (e) To maintain the hygiene among girl students, institution launched an incinerator for disposal of sanitary napkins at girls' common room.
- (f) The Institution has installed Sensor Based Sanitizer Dispenser for health and hygiene.
- (g) The Institute has taken initiative to enhance awareness and responsibility towards environment.
 - (i) One hour power cut per week to enable the students to be aware of energy saving process.
 - (ii) Signages on Energy Conservation, Water Conservation etc. on and around the classrooms ensure students towards the environment and judicious use of resources.
 - (iii) On the motto 'Reuse and Recycle', the Institution developed Eco-brick Project and hands on practice to enable the students to learn about the procedure of reduction of one time used plastic from environment.
 - (iv) To make the student conscious about the environmental sustainability, National and International Webinar on emerging topic have been organized.
 - (v) To make students responsible towards environment, the Institution has celebrated days like Earth Day, Science Day, Environment Day and wetland Day.
 - (vi) Plantation of NASA recommended low cost, low maintenance and evergreen eco-friendly air purifier plant like snake plant in the staff room, laboratory etc. to make a positive vibes among students.
 - (vii) Students and staff enthusiastically initiate and participate in the tree plantation drive in and around the campus.
